Funeral services for Victor Schimank, 82, of Giddings are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 9, 2014 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Texas with Rev. Dale Bohm officiating. Victor Erwin Schimank was born on October 20, 1931 in Fedor, Texas to Emil and Martha (Becker) Schimank. He was baptized on November 1, 1931 and confirmed on March 25, 1945 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor, Texas by Rev. Adolph Michalk. His confirmation verse was Romans 8: 31-32, "What then shall we say of these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?" Victor was united in marriage to Mary Ella Boriack on February 4, 1951 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Texas by Rev. H.A. Stroebel.
