For example, when visiting Reynosa she'd have her children gift articles of clothing to "street children" stating "I'll buy you another. These children need them." Her generosity was immeasurable.

With a zest for life, she loved Mexican music, especially rancheras. She would listen while sewing, cooking, or working on housework. Dancing at fiestas with her loved one pleased her immensely.

As a woman of faith and the heart of her family, she tirelessly placed everyone's needs before hers. She assisted in childcare of all of her grandchildren who she loved.
