



Dr. Vincent "Vince" Howard Stewart

January 11, 1953 - August 16, 2021

Funeral services for Dr. Vincent "Vince" Stewart, 68, of Giddings, Texas, are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 19, 2021 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Texas with Rev. Dale Bohm officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, August 18, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Thursday, August 19, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The family will be present for visitation Wednesday evening from 6:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.

Vincent Howard Stewart was born on January 11, 1953 in Austin, Texas, the son of Dr. John Franklin Stewart Jr. and Frances Lillian (Bour) Stewart. Vince graduated from Giddings High School in 1971 where he excelled in football being named to the 1970 Class AA All State Football Team. He went on to graduate from Texas Chiropractic College in Pasadena. He worked for Powell Electric in Houston while attending college. Vince moved back to Giddings where he was a chiropractor at Giddings Chiropractic for over 20 years. On April 24, 1982, Vince was united in marriage to Rose Marie (Rackel) Zoch at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Margaret Catholic Church in Giddings and after their marriage, he became a member of St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln through adult confirmation on March 25, 1984. His confirmation verse was Ephesians 2:8-9, "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this is not from yourselves, it

is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast." Vince enjoyed raising birds and working with his bird dogs. He was also a Ham Radio Operator. Vince enjoyed riding his Harley and he and Sean often made road trips and attended many bike rallies. After retiring several years ago due to health issues, Vince enjoyed simpler things like visits from his friends and spending time with his family, especially his children and grandchildren.

Vince passed away on Monday, August 16, 2021 at St. David's Medical Center in Austin.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Dr. John and Frances Stewart; his wife, Rose Stewart; two brothers, Greg Stewart and Jack Stewart & his wife, Carole, and his parents-in-law, Elmo & Elyne Rackel.
