



## Walter E. Schulze

Funeral services for Walter E. Schulze will be held at the St. Paul Lutheran Church in Serbin, TX on Monday December 1, 2008 beginning at 10:00 AM. He was called to his Savior's side and eternal home on Thursday, November 27, 2008. Walter was the son of Alvin Schulze and Alma Schubert Schulze. He was born again into the kingdom of God Through Holy Baptism on June 24, 1928 at St. Paul Lutheran Church of Serbin by Pastor Herman Schmidt. He confirmed his faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as his Savior and the Lord of Life at St. Paul Lutheran in Serbin, March 29, 1942 under Pastor Herman Schmidt. His Confirmation verse was Psalm 1:1-2: "Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinner, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night." to Serbin where he was engaged in ranching. Walter was preceded in death by his parents, four sisters and two brothers. Walter is survived by his wife of 57 years, Verline.
