McCullough Jr. on January 11, 1964 at Christ Lutheran Church in Austin by Rev. Theodore R. Griesse. While living in Austin, Weaver worked in retail and took care of children. She was an active member of St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln where she had served as a Sunday school teacher and was a member of the Ladies Aid. She was a member of the Lincoln Volunteer Fire Department, the Lincoln Community Center and the Lutheran Braille Workers. She also served as an officer and volunteered her time with Rejuvenation in Giddings. Weaver enjoyed quilting, cross stitching, knitting, cooking and gardening. She was an avid reader who never missed her daily bible study. Weaver passed away the evening of Wednesday, July 17, 2013 at the Cedar View Rehabilitation and Healthcare Center in Austin.
