

Weldon Puckett

April 13, 1925 - December 25, 2014

Memorial services for Weldon Puckett, age 89 of Rockdale are scheduled for 1:00 p.m. Tuesday, December 30, 2014 at Phillips & Luckey Funeral Home with Rev. Adam Straznicky of St. John's United Methodist Church in Rockdale officiating.

Weldon Puckett was born April 13, 1925 in Flat, Texas to Noel Ennis and Sydney (Gallaway) Puckett. Weldon served in the U.S. Navy. On December 29, 1945 he and Ernestine Emmert were married in Killeen. To this union two children were born. They moved to the Rockdale area where they made their home the past 62 years. Weldon worked as a foreman and conductor for the Rockdale Sandow and Southern Railroad, retiring in 1971. He also worked as a butcher at McVoy's Grocery and Feed Store in Rockdale and was a rancher. He was a member of Trinity Methodist Church in Thorndale, Rockdale V.F.W. Post 6525 and member of Thorndale Masonic Lodge over 50 years.

Weldon passed away Thursday night, December 25th, in the Winnie L. Nursing Home in Cameron. He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife Ernestine Puckett on June 11, 2007; their son, David Puckett on January 19, 2006; grandson, Trent Remaley on February 15, 2013 and Weldon's brothers and sisters.

His is survived by daughter, Glorya Puckett and husband John of Coleman;

daughter-in-law, Marsha Puckett of Bryan; three grandchildren, Melissa Remaley Pomykal, Kerri Hillman and Kyler Puckett; five great-grandchildren, Brittny, Cierra, Payton, Jeannie Marie, Jessie and one great-great-grandson, Zayden.
