Funeral services for Werner "Sonkie" Jatzlau, 90, and Gloria "Nicky" Jatzlau, 87, both of Dime Box, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 14, 2021 at Trinity Lutheran Church in Old Dime Box, Texas with Rev. Bernard Schey officiating. Services will be live streamed though the Trinity Lutheran Dime Box Facebook page. Burial will follow in the St. John Lutheran Cemetery in Dime Box, Texas. Visitation will be held on Wednesday, January 13, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and on Thursday, January 14, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. at Phillips and Luckey Funeral Home in Giddings. The Jatzlau family will be present for visitation Wednesday evening from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Werner Erwin "Sonkie" Jatzlau was born on July 2, 1930 in Fedor, Texas to Carl Oswald and Ida Matilda (Symmank) Jatzlau. Gloria Ann "Nicky" (Kasper) Jatzlau was born on March 13, 1933 in Dime Box, Texas to Charles Ernest and Alberta Lois (Grundmann) Kasper. The Jatzlaus were united in marriage on July 1, 1950 at St. John Lutheran Church in Lincoln, Texas. Sonkie and Nicky owned and operated Jatzlau Grocery in Dime Box for 35 years. Sonkie was also a carpenter and built many of the houses in Dime Box. They were members of the SPJST Lodge #13 in Dime Box and they managed the hall during special events for many years. Sonkie was a member of the Dime Box Volunteer Fire Department and enjoyed hunting, fishing, gardening, and working with his cattle. He was a talented musician who could play almost any

instrument. Nicky enjoyed reading, quilting, crocheting, canning, cooking and hunting with Sonkie. She loved volunteering her time with different things in town and had served as the organist for church.

Sonkie passed away the evening of Thursday, January 7, 2021 and Nicky passed away the next day on Friday, January 8, 2021 at Seton Medical Center in Austin.

Sonkie is preceded in death by his parents, Carl & Ida Jatzlau, and three siblings, Ernie Jackowski, Oswald Jatzlau, and Gilbert Jatzlau.

Nicky is preceded in death by her parents, Charles & Alberta Kasper.

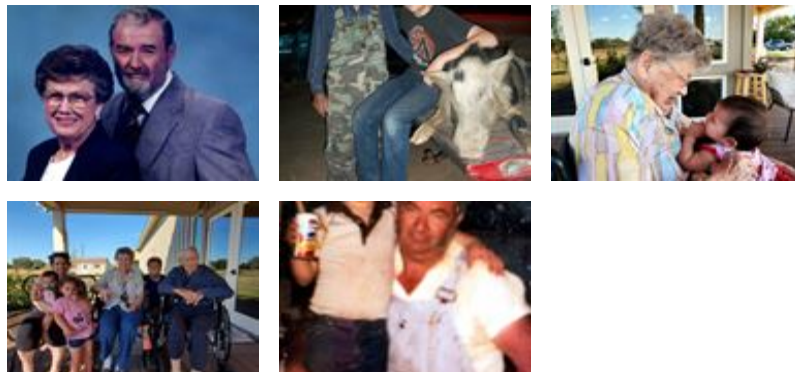
