



## Wilbert Lee Wenzel

January 4, 1938 - June 11, 2017

Wilbert Lee Wenzel, 79 of Rockdale, passed away Sunday, June 11, 2017. A memorial service will be held on Saturday, June 17, 2017 at 2:00 pm at First Baptist Church in Rockdale with Pastor Matt Higginbotham officiating.

Lee was born January 4, 1938 in Rockdale, Texas to Hugo August and Lizzie (Stork) Wenzel. He attended schools in Sharp, Coupland and Elgin. Lee married Cynthia Galfas on August 25, 1961 in Houston, Texas. He enlisted in the National Guard in 1960 and was honorably discharged in 1962. Lee then served in the United States Army during the Cuban Missile Crisis before being honorably discharged in 1965. He worked at Randall's in Houston as the Meat Market Manager for 40 years before retiring in 1992. They came to Rockdale, where he then raised turkeys until 2012. His farm was the 1999 Growout Farm Runner Up and in 2004 he received the 1st Place Environmental Award. Lee was raised in the Lutheran Church and was a member of Peace Lutheran Church in Rockdale, Texas. He enjoyed working on the farm as well as tending to his cows and his land, but most of all, he enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren.

He is preceded in death by his son, Steven Carroll Wenzel on June 17, 1978; father and mother, Hugo August in 1974 and Lizzie Wenzel in 2007; brother, Carroll Roy Wenzel in 1947; and father-in-law and mother-in-law, Count and Tena Galfas.
