



## William Wayne Albers

November 20, 1932 - January 5, 2015

Funeral services for William Albers, 82 of Ledbetter, Texas, are scheduled for 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 8, 2015 at St. Margaret's Catholic Church in Giddings with Father James Olhausen officiating. Burial will immediately follow in the Waldeck Cemetery in Waldeck, Texas. William Wayne Albers was born on November 20, 1932 on the family farm in Ledbetter, Texas to Fred Otto Albers and Clara Augusta (Weber) Albers. He served in the U.S. Army with the Occupation Forces in Germany during the Korean Conflict. William was united in marriage to Jacqueline Buckner on December 31, 1955 at Holy Name Catholic Church in Houston, Texas. He worked as a machine operator with the American Can Company in Houston, Texas for many years. After retiring, he and Jackie moved back to the family farm in Ledbetter where William could usually be found doing anything outdoors. He enjoyed gardening, working in his yard and fishing. The last few years he spent time watching sports on television, reading and doing word search and word puzzles. William was a member of St. Margaret's Catholic Church and had been a member of the Knights of Columbus and the Carmine

Lions Club. He passed away suddenly on the afternoon of Monday, January 5, 2015 at his home in Ledbetter.

William was preceded in death by his parents, Fred & Clara Albers; his brother, Louis "Buck" Albers; his sister-in-law, Ethel Mae Buckner and his two brothers-in-law, Aubrey "Buck" Buckner and Jimmy Buckner.

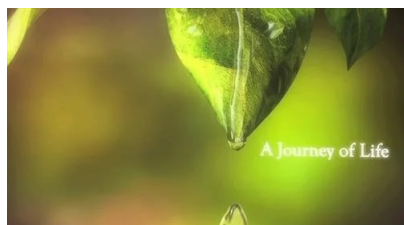

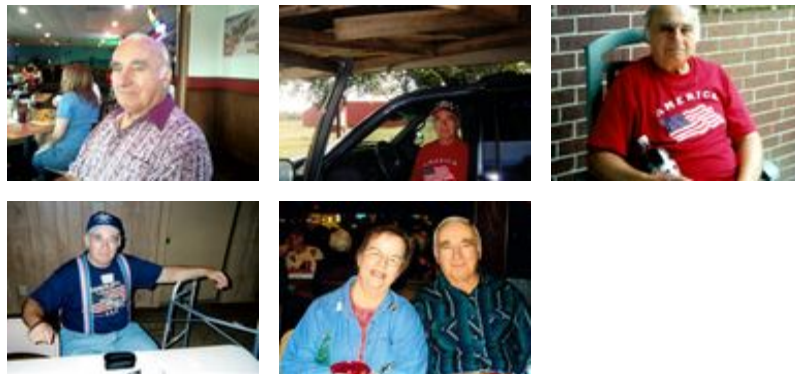
