



## William "Bill" Hugh Cain

August 13, 1949 - May 24, 2019

Funeral services for William "Bill" Cain, 69, of Paige, Texas, are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 30, 2019 at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor, Texas with Rev. Jonathan Meyer officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. William Hugh Cain was born on August 13, 1949 in Austin, Texas to William Leroy Cain and Mary Evelyn (Bieze) Cain. He attended Reagan and LBJ High Schools before beginning a lifelong career in fire safety equipment. Bill worked first for Safequip and then AAA Fire and Safety for many years. He was united in marriage to Betty Jean Richter on April 6, 1974 in Austin, Texas. Together they had two children, Beverly and William. He was baptized and confirmed on April 18, 1976 at Salem Lutheran Church in Austin by Rev. A.L. Pfeneg. His confirmation verse was Acts 1:8, "But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth". He was currently a member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Fedor. Bill was always active in the volunteer fire departments in the areas that his family lived. He had served as a member of the Buda V.F.D., the Manchaca V.F.D. and most recently, the Paige V.F.D. He enjoyed football and baseball and volunteered

as a coach for his son's little league teams for many years. Bill also loved fishing and many of his happiest times were spent sitting on his boat in an area lake with his fishing line in the water.

Bill passed away unexpectedly the evening of Friday, May 24, 2019 at his home in Paige.

He was preceded in death by his parents, William & Mary Cain; his in-laws, Albert & Alwina Richter; his son-in-law, John Kelley; two nieces, Christine Grady and Tammy Graybill, and one nephew, Howard Grady.

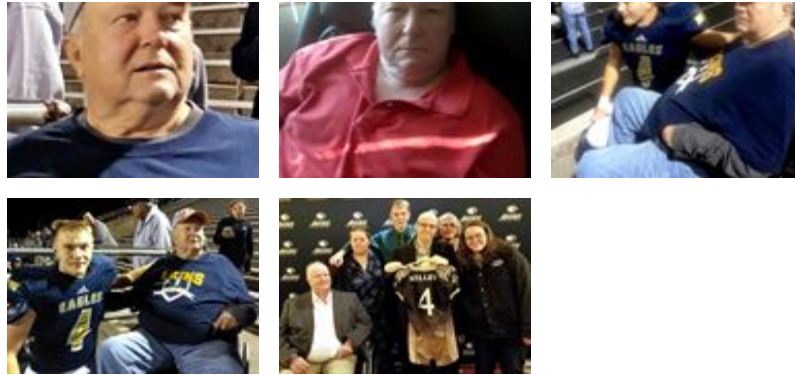
