William was able to travel to all 50 states doing what he loved. He also enjoyed working on cars and had a natural skill for fixing things. Family was

always important to him and he looked forward to making meals for them when they would come to visit.

William was received into the loving arms of the Lord on Tuesday, April 18, 2023 at his home in San Antonio.

He was preceded in death by his father, Jesse Hamilton, and brother-in-law, Dominique Banister.

William leaves to mourn his passing his mother, Alice Hamilton of Dime Box; three siblings, Willie Lewis Sr. and his wife Elizabeth of Dallas, James Hamilton of San Antonio, and Beverly Banister of Round Rock, and a host of nieces, nephews, other family members and friends.
