



William "Bill" Proctor

Services for William "Bill" Proctor, age 90 of Rockdale will be 10:00 AM Graveside service on Monday, September 15, 2014 at the I.O.O.F. Cemetery in Rockdale with Dr. Greg Nichols officiating. After graveside services there will be a 11:00 AM Memorial Service at First Presbyterian Church in Rockdale with a reception following the memorial service at the church fellowship hall. Public visitation will be Sunday from 2:00 until 5:00 PM at the funeral home. The family will not be present at the visitation, but please come by.

Bill was born December 13, 1923 in Durham, North Carolina and was the son of William Leland Proctor, Sr. and Willie (Glinn) Proctor. He graduated from Durham High School in 1941 and from North Carolina State in 1948. He was an engineer with Alcoa for 39 years working at Badin, North Carolina, Alcoa Tennessee, and Rockdale, Texas. He and Sara Sanders were married on June 4, 1955 in Badin, North Carolina. Bill died on Wednesday, September 10, 2014 at his home in Rockdale.

Bill was active in First Presbyterian Church in Rockdale as an Elder. He served on numerous committees for his church and is remembered in Badin as a favorite Sunday school teacher. He served for thirteen years on the Milam County Appraisal Board. He also worked with Literacy Volunteers and East Side tutoring.

He is preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his wife Sara Proctor of Rockdale. A son Richard Leland Proctor and wife Jeannie of Burlington, North Carolina. Two daughters, Saralynn Proctor Torres of Rowlett, Texas and Emily Proctor Gallagher and husband Pat of Florence, Alabama. Seven grandchildren, Daniel Proctor and wife Ann, Drew Proctor, Allison Rampy and husband Chase, Claire Riepe and husband Gavin, Matt Torres, Patton Gallagher, and Maggie Gallagher. Five great grandchildren, William and Sadie Proctor, Katelyn and Reese Rampy, and Hank Riepe.
